## **FYP Symposium Spring 2019**

Around 32 projects of more than 100 students working in different teams, were on display in FYP I and FYP II. A coterie of faculty and eminent guests from industry and academia were invited to evaluate the projects as esteemed judges. The event was organized by Projects Manager FYP, FCS IBA, Mr. Waseem Arain.

Associate Dean, IBA, Dr. Sayeed Ghani, who remained present and evaluated extensively, expressed satisfaction and confidence in continuing improvement in students' quality of work. Chairman, Department of Computer Science IBA, Dr. Shakeel Khoja also took interest in students' evaluations.

The students incorporated latest technologies in their projects to provide solutions to daily life issues. Most of the projects were innovative in terms of ideas, and implementation, which were encouraged by the industry professionals to be pursued further. The interaction of students with the corporate personnel gave them a perspective of the corporate environment and the modifications that would help them raise the standards of their work.

# ACCW conducts a dramatic reading of **Manto's selected works**





Attendees discussed how they had been introduced to Manto's work and how his stories focused on aspects that seem to have been erased from history, portraying the beastly side of humans, particularly in the backdrop of the partition, bringing out how it meant different things for different people. One student pointed out how Manto focused mainly on the specification of the partition of introducing Manto to those who had been curious about his work.



# Webinar on **Trade and Development Report 2018**



May 3, 2019: A webinar was organized at the IBA by Assistant Professor and Research Fellow (CBER), Dr. Aadil Nakhoda, in collaboration with the United Nations Conference on Trade and Development (UNCTAD). The representatives from the UN office discussed the findings of the Trade and Development Report 2018 focusing on the theme of Power, Platform and the Free Trade Delusion. The presentation focused on the aftermath of the global financial crisis; global value chains; structure of free trade agreements, with a shift towards legal protection of intellectual property and promotion of investment protectionism; how economic policies can be adapted to the digital world; and the Global Green New Deal. The session ended with a Q&A session, where the audience enquired how Pakistan can benefit in this entire landscape and how its policies have changed over the years with respect to trade. In response, the representatives highlighted that students from institutions such as the IBA are future policy and law makers, thus entrusting them with an important role in how trade policies are shaped.
