Distinguished Lecture Series on The Economy of Modern Sindh by Dr. Ishrat Husain

April 20, 2019: IBA, Karachi organized a *Distinguished Lecture Series* by the Adviser to the Prime Minister on Institutional Reforms and Austerity, Dr. Ishrat Husain, on his co-authored book, *The Economy of Modern Sindh*. The lecture was attended by IBA faculty, alumni, students, general public and media personnel.

ED IBA Karachi, Dr. Farrukh Iqbal, moderated the session which aimed at discussing the socioeconomic problems that have plagued Sindh, and the various policies implemented over the years, as well as reforms at the sectoral and micro level that are required within the province. The target audience as highlighted by Dr. Husain includes; students of Economics that need to view the economy at a disaggregated level, policy makers, and young researchers such as Ph.D. students that require access to consistent data sources. The lecture ended with the audience asking questions on Sindh's economy and education, followed by a book signing.

First ever 30-hour **Data Science Hackathon** takes place in Pakistan

April 21, 2019: IBA, Karachi made history by hosting the first ever *Data Science Hackathon* sponsored by a New York-based Data Analytics start up – Inqline at IBA, main campus. The 30-hour long Hackathon was a first of its kind in Pakistan in which 28 teams comprising of over 100 students from 12 universities across Pakistan competed to promote the use of machine learning to bring about social innovation.

The students got a hands-on experience with real-life data from Husaini Blood Bank which partnered in the hackathon by providing blood donors' data. This data set was analysed by the competing students, in which they predicted the prevalence of various diseases that are typically found in the donated data.



The event began with keynote speaker sessions by Associate Dean, Faculty of Computer Science at IBA, Dr. Sayeed Ghani, followed by Chief Executive Officer and founder of Ingline, Muhammad Atif.

The judges panel consisted of notable Data Science experts and university professors. After the presentations, the judges announced the results and declared Data Squad from NED University as the winners and F.A.S.T from Habib University as the runners-up. The winning team was awarded an amount of Rs. 100,000 along with a paid internship for one of the team members at Inqline's headquarter in New York City, while the runners-up were given a cash reward of Rs. 60,000.

Informative session by AGAHI

April 25, 2019: AGAHI held their sixth training session on the usefulness of The Pakistan State of the Future Index (PK-SOFI), launched on October 22, 2017 by the Foresight Lab. This session took place in collaboration with the Dadabhoy Foundation at IBA, Karachi. A number of academic scholars from the fields of media communication, political science, computer science and finance attended the session.

The Founder and President of AGAHI, Ms. Puruesh Chaudhary introduced the Foresight Lab to the participants. The Foresight Lab is a platform for strategic thinking, which improves policy-making and enables strategic planning and action into implementation. Ms. Chaudhary emphasized on the use of Foresight Lab as an open, systematic, participatory process that supports research design and formulation of policies. This session included a step-by-step training on how to navigate the software.



Anti-harassment awareness campaign
